Get sublimation printer

-Epson or Sawgrass

All depends on your budget. Epson Ecotank 2720, 2760, 3710, 3760, 4700, 4760, 15000, 16600.

Epson SureColor F170, SureColor F570, SureColor F6370. Any Sawgrass printer.

Get sublimation paper

-TexPrint XPHR

This is my personal recommendation because this is what I use. It's never let me down. There are plenty of options are there though! See next page

Get sublimation ink

-Cosmos Ink

This is my recommendation. Make sure to sign up for their email list to stay up to date when paper is in stock. You'd learn a lot from his Youtube videos.

Get heat press
